Some process goals do not contain trade-offs; how can I use these options in my project planning?	Great question! These missing trade-offs for process options are coming in our 2023 roadmap—expected to be released by Q2.  In the meantime, please see the additional resources found under each of these process blades.
Can I export the process goal diagram as an image?	Yes, you can export the process goal diagram as an image. Select a goal diagram and select the dropdown box in the top-right-hand corner, "Export Diagram." Choose an export type.
Can I export the process goal text as PDF?	No. Exporting a goal diagram and its text as a PDF is not a feature since our last release. PMI has this feature on our roadmap for 2024—no expected release date.
Additional resources links are not working; is there a problem?	If the Additional Resources link is not working, you are likely using version 5.0 or earlier. Make sure you're using at least version 5.1 or later.  If you still encounter a problem using one of the latest versions of DA Browser, please contact our support team at <a href="mailto:support@pmi.org">support@pmi.org</a> .
Can I download the DA Browser as an App for my desktop?	Downloading the DA Browser as an App to the desktop is one of our most requested features.  PMI plans to have this on the roadmap by 2024 but does not have an expected release date.  Once released, PMI expects the browser to be compatible with Mac, Windows and some Linux distros.
Can I enter text to make notes?	As of December 2022, there is no functionality for a user to enter text. However, some users have successfully copied the text into a word doc table and made the notes they want.

Is there a charge for using the DA Browser?	No. PMI does not charge for using or sharing the DA Browser. All features are free for everyone to use and reference.
Can I pay to receive additional features?	No pay structure is in effect or planned on the 2023 roadmap. Therefore, all features you currently see in DA Browser are features available.
